Online Safety News

New research has just been published by Qoria about the risks to our children from harmful content online. and in particular relating to AI (Artificial Intelligence) During a poll of schools in the UK it was found that :

- 11.2 % of children were experiencing incidents of possessing, sharing or requesting nude content by students at least once a week
- 36% of children in the UK were experiencing incidents of possessing, sharing or requesting nude content by students at least once every 4 months
- This is occuring most commonly with children aged between 11–13 years of age
- 57.5% of children in the age range 11–13 years had reported experiencing explicit content in the UK
- 21% of respondents in the UK said that they were seeing this behaviour in students as young as 8–10 years of age
