### **We need your help re: Nut Allergy**

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has come to our attention that a child in our school has a severe allergic reaction to peanuts/nuts. This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of peanut/nut products and cross contamination.

Since this condition can be life threatening, we are asking for your help in minimising the risk to this child by:

- a) Avoiding giving children peanuts in school lunches or for snacks**
- b) Avoiding giving peanut butter sandwiches, other spreads containing nuts such as Nutella and snacks/bars containing nuts**
- c) Food labelled "may contain nut traces" are ok to have in your child's school lunches**
- d) Asking children not to share their lunches.**

Due to the severity of the problem, it is important that all parents carry out the suggested measures and reduce the risk of allergic reaction to this child.
