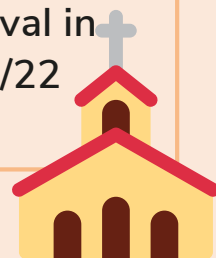
Young voices

We can guarantee some beautiful singing. All we ask is that children donate a tin or a packet of food for the church's food bank. See you there.

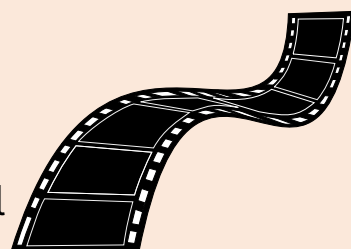
School photos

Your child will come home with details of how to purchase photographs after the event.

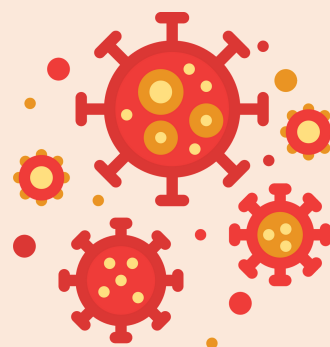


Flu vaccination
